

## **Coastal Pet Rescue Pet Disaster Packing Checklist**

Plan ahead for your pets. If you know you are going to take them with you, create a disaster kit to help you and keep your pet comfortable during the evacuation. The kit should contain\*:

For all pets:

- Enough food and water for a week
- Food and water dish
- Current Medications
- Collar with id & rabies tag
- Pet carrier/crate & bedding
- A few favorite toys
- Flea collar/pills/drops
- Heartworm Preventative
- Pet first aid kit & book
- Pet's medical records
- Recent color photo of your pet

For dogs:

- Leash
- Choke collar, harness, and/or muzzle (to keep control over your dog)
- Quiet chew toys (enough for a week)

For cats:

- Litter box & litter
- Trash bags for refuse
- Quiet toys to bat around

Consider microchipping your pet as a means of permanent identification. Be sure to update your pet's information in the microchip registry prior to an evacuation.
